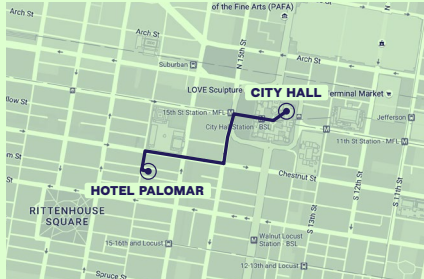

Depart Hotel Palomar

Head north on 17th Street, walk five blocks

Turn left onto Benjamin Franklin Parkway, walk one block

Turn left on 18th Street, The Logan will be on your right

Upon entry to The Logan, The Library will be on your immediate left

If you prefer transportation:
Hotel Palomar doormen will be available to hail a taxi cabs for attendees. Uber is available in Philadelphia.

Return transportation from the dinner to Hotel Palomar will be made available upon request.

Depart Hotel Palomar

Head north on 17th Street, walk one block

Turn right onto Chestnut Street, walk two blocks

Turn left onto 15th Street, walk one block

The southwest corner of City Hall will be on your right

Cross through Dilworth Park and around City Hall to the Visitor's Entrance located on the northeast corner of the building near the intersection of John F. Kennedy Boulevard and North Juniper Street

Once inside, a staff member will direct you to Conversation Hall, located on the Second Floor of City Hall

Transportation will be provided for the tour of Bartram's Garden and Mile on the afternoon of September 9.
