

-Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad, 55 miles


-Cuyahoga Valley National Park

The connecting thread: the Ohio & Erie Canal and Towpath Trail.






When complete, the Towpath will be a 101-mile recreational trail, traveling from Cleveland to New Philadelphia along the historic Ohio & Erie Canal.




